Entry Acceptance Method and Opening Date: Entries postmarked before February 4, 2008 will not be accepted. Entry POSTMARK DATE will determine the acceptance order. Hand-stamped postmarks are recommended. There is no need to overnight entries. In accordance with NADAC guidelines, priority entry will be given to a limited number of exhibitors who volunteer to help work at our trial.

Closing Date: All entries must be RECEIVED no later than March 29th. Entries are limited to 400 total runs per day. Entries not filled out correctly or sent with an incorrect amount of fees will not be accepted. We reserve the right to refuse any entry. Anyone who is not currently in good standing with NADAC will not be allowed entry into the trial.

Entry Fees: \$12/run Standard and Veterans; \$9/run Junior Handlers

Entry Changes: Accepted entries may be changed prior to Monday April 7th. E-mail requests to Erin Wajda at trialsec@northeastagility.com, or call 518-203-3092 (e-mail is preferred). When you request changes please identify the trial date, dog, owner, dog's NADAC number, and the requested change. Any changes made after the closing date will cost \$5.00 per change REGARDLESS OF WHO IS AT FAULT so please check your confirmation carefully! You will receive e-mail confirmation of any requested change. I am usually able to respond within 2 weekdays. If you do not receive a response from me then please e-mail me again. No changes will be made at the trial so please read your confirmations carefully!

Move-Ups: Move-ups between days will be allowed at this trial providing the request is made by the close of the trial on Saturday.

Refunds: There shall be no refunds for entries withdrawn in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of the reason for such dismissal. Refunds are allowed if requested before the closing date. Refunds after closing date will be honored only for bitches in season and injured dogs with a veterinarian's note as long as the request is received in writing by 8:00PM on Thursday April 10th. A \$5.00 processing fee will be assessed for ANY refund. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, snow, acts of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond our control.

Canadian Competitors: All fees must be submitted in U.S. Funds via International Postal Money Order or checks from an account using U.S. Funds with "U.S. Funds" clearly written on the check.

Bad Checks: Any person who writes a check for "insufficient funds" and/or otherwise a "bad check" will not be allowed to participate in this event until a money order or cashier's check for the amount of the original check plus \$40.00 is received.

Clean-Up: Clean-Up at the show site is a must! You will be asked to leave the site and your scores will not be sent to NADAC if you do not clean up after your dog(s) and yourselves.

Food: Limited drinks and snacks will be provided for volunteer workers only. Other than that, there will be no food available so please be prepared to bring your own.

Awards: First through fourth place ribbons will be awarded for each jump height in all classes and levels. Qualifying ribbons for both NADAC and AMBOR will be awarded for any qualifying run. Please note that Chances is Pass/Fail and will not have placement ribbons.

Registration / Starting Times: Daily registration and walkthroughs will be from 7:30 – 8:00 A.M. Briefings will begin at 8:00 A.M with the first dog on the line IMMEDIATELY AFTERWARD.

Running Orders: No extra copies of the catalog will be available at the trial, so if you would like your own copy of the running order, please print one out from the website. If you wish to have the catalog printed out for you, the trial secretary will provide copies at a cost of \$1.00 per catalog provided that you make your request prior to 8:00 PM on Wednesday April 9th by calling 518-203-3092 or e-mailing trialsec@northeastagility.com, e-mail is preferred. Requested copies will be available during check-in.

The Management will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor whether the result was by accident or any other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and custody and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show Committee be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of fees paid will be made and no scores will be submitted. In addition, the NADAC office will be informed of the problem.

Obstacles: The following obstacles will be available at this agility trial: Dog Walk, A Frame, Open Tunnel, Weave Poles, Non-Wing Jump, Hoops. The contact obstacles will have rubber surfacing.

Hoopers: If time allows we will be offering the Hoopers class on Saturday. Sign-up sheets will be available at the trial. The cost will be \$5 per run. Please see the current Exhibitor's Handbook for a description of the class.

Driving Directions

From Taconic State Parkway: Take exit for Rt. 199 (Red Hook, Rhinebeck). Bear right at the 1st light. Turn left at the next light onto Rt. 9 south to Rhinebeck. Go straight through the light at the 4-way intersection. The Fairgrounds will be on the left. Turn left onto Mulberry St. (Coon's Florist). Turn right at the stop sign. The trial is on the right across from the grandstand.

From Rt. 9 south: Go straight through the light in the village of Rhinebeck (Beekman Arms will be on left). Continue on Rt. 9, the hospital will be on left. Turn right onto Mulberry St. (Coon's Florist). Follow the directions from above.

New York State Thruway: Take exit 19 to Rt. 209 North. Go over the Kingston/Rhinecliff Bridge. At the 2nd light turn right onto Rt. 9G. At the next light turn right onto Rt. 9. The fairgrounds will be up ahead on the left. Turn left onto Mulberry St. (Coon's florist). Follow the directions from above.

NADAC Information

Notice to Exhibitors: This show will be held under the current rules and regulations of NADAC. Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of NADAC rules and regulations, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of the trial. An exhibitor's handbook may be obtained from the NADAC website at www.nadac.com or by submitting a request to NADAC, P.O. Box 1206, Colbert, OK, 74733.

Divisions, Classes & Levels: Please visit the NADAC website at www.nadac.com for current rules and regulations.

Non-Jumping Classes-Veteran or Disabled Handler: Handlers aged 60 years or older or who have a disability that restricts mobility may opt to enter the non-jumping classes as a Veteran Handler, which would allow for a 10% increase in the standard course time. This option is for Veteran/Disabled handlers in the non-jumping classes only.

The Veteran/Disabled Handler division is designed for handlers who, due to age or impairment, are mobility limited and need extra time to guide their canine partners through an agility course.

When entering as a Veteran/Disabled Handler, you must enter all dogs in all classes for the entire trial in this Division and must jump 4" lower than your Proficient, Standard Division jump height requires. In the non-jumping classes, dogs will be scored and placed with their Standard Division jump height.

Proficient/Skilled Categories: Each class will be split into two categories, Proficient and Skilled. In the Skilled Category, dogs *may* jump 4" lower than indicated by the current jump height table. (No dog may jump less than 4").

In the Regular class, a five point qualifying round with 5 or fewer faults (course/time) can be earned only by dogs entered in the Skilled Category. In the Proficient Category, qualifying rounds must be clean with no course faults or time faults.

All special award plaques and NATCH plaques are earned in the Proficient Category. Special certificates and medals are earned in the Skilled Category.

Courses are the same for both categories. When entering a trial, you must indicate what category you are entering for the entire weekend.

Important: Please check your dog's NADAC registration number on your trial confirmation as soon as you receive it; also, please check the copy of the results posted at the trial. You should report any errors to the Trial Secretary immediately.

NADAC records trial results as they are submitted by the host clubs/groups. The individual trial results submitted by the club are uploaded to the files section of the NADACagility@yahoo.com list within two weeks after the NADAC office receives them from the club. The trial results will remain on the list for at least thirty (30) days. Please accept the responsibility to review those results, and check that your registration number and qualifying points, as reported by the club, are correct. You can join the www.NADACagility@yahoo.com list and set your settings to "no mail". You will be able to view trial results and check for any possible discrepancies, without receiving list mail. If you find an error in the reporting of your dog's qualifying points or registration number, please contact the host club. The host club is responsible for correcting any errors and informing NADAC.

Levels: Points earned at a higher level of a class, prior to the completion of the lower level title, will not be banked by NADAC for future use. If a dog earns points in a level of a class that they are not eligible to title in, those points will not be added to the dog's records.

Skilled: Any dog entering the Skilled Category *may* jump one jump height lower than the heights listed in the above table. No dog may jump lower than 4".

Measuring: Only dogs in the Proficient Category that have a wither height of 18" and under are required to be measured. Dogs jumping 20" and 20+ are not required to be measured, including Veteran dogs that jump 16". Dogs entered in the Skilled Category are not required to be measured.

AGREEMENT

1.1 As used here NADAC means North American Dog Agility Council, its members, officers, directors, employees, show chairs, show committees and agents.

1.2 Exhibitor/owner, agree to abide by the rules and regulations of NADAC, AMBOR and any other rules and regulations appearing in the premium for this event.

1.3 Exhibitor/owner certify that the entered dog is not a hazard to persons, dogs or property and that the entered dog's rabies vaccination is current in accordance with the requirement of the state in which the dog resides.

1.4 Exhibitor/owner acknowledge all hazards presented by the event and the event premises, including but not limited to, the condition of the floors, stairways, halls, lighting, security measures or lack of, electrical appliances, fitting, show rings, parking areas and the presence of unfamiliar animals and people; exhibitor and owner assume the risk of any harm arising from these.

1.5 Exhibitor/owner release NADAC (Including NADAC officers directors, employees and members), and Play~Bow Dog Training (including its officers, members, and event organizing committee), and will defend them and hold them harmless from all present and future loss, injury, damage, claims, demands and liabilities involving the entered dog, the event or event premises. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing hold harmless provisions, exhibitor/owner hereby specifically assume sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damages because of bodily injuries, including death, at any time in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, howsoever such injury or death may be caused and whether or not the same may have been caused or may have been alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents or any other persons.
